1. Endorsement of WACS Global Culinary Competition

Marketing Rules:

Fees to WACS 2500 Euro in advance. (Payable once the criteria has been met and agreed by the Culinary Committee rules). The local Continental Director for the region is responsible to ensure payment is paid.
Organized by WACS or a national Association.
One free booth for WACS, at least 3 x 4 Meter including electrical connection and Internet access.
At every location of the show there must be WACS banners /flags (will be provided by WACS).
The WACS President will be invited to the opening and closing ceremonies. All costs are born by the organiser.
All brochures of the Culinary Competition as well as the website have to show the WACS logo.
Both Web sites are to be linked.
All brochures of the Culinary Competition as well as the website have to include "WACS endorsed Culinary Competition".
All certificates have to bear name and signature of the WACS President and the WACS logo.

WACS will provide an Observer on their own cost.
WACS publishes this Culinary Competition on their own website.
WACS intensively conducts promotion for this Culinary Competition.

National Teams, Junior National Teams, Military Teams: 5 jurors for each category (5 are called forward by WACS, of at least 4 different nationalities and 4 differing WACS associations). All WACS approved judges (Category: Global & International)

Regional teams and individual exhibitor: 3 jurors for each category, 3 different nationalities and 3 different associations. All WACS approved judges (Category: Global & International)

The judging list must be shown to the Culinary Competition Committee, 3 months in advance of the show.

A WACS Observer, (WACS approved)

At least 18 senior national teams are exhibiting

2. Endorsement of WACS International Culinary Competition

Marketing Rules:

Fees to WACS 1500 Euro in advance. (Payable once the criteria has been met and agreed by the Culinary Committee rules). The local Continental Director for the region is responsible to ensure payment is paid Organised by WACS, or a national Association.

One free booth for WACS, at least 3 x 4 Meter including electrical connection and Internet access.

At every location of the Culinary Competition there must be WACS banners /flags (will be provided by WACS).

The WACS President will be invited to the opening and closing ceremonies. All costs are born by the organiser.

All brochures of the Culinary Competition as well as the website have to show the WACS logo. Both Web sites are to be linked.

Jury: Regional teams, Company teams, Individual exhibitor: 3 jurors for each category (2 are called forward by WACS, 1 are called forward by National association, of at least 2 different nationalities and 2 differing associations) All WACS approved judges (Category: Global & International)

The complete judging list must be shown to the Culinary Competition Committee, 3 months in advance of the show.

A WACS Observer, (WACS approved)

At least 10 senior national teams are exhibiting

Organized by WACS, or a national association, or a regional association
Free WACS Info counter, shared with the organiser.

Both Web sites are to be linked.
All brochures of the Culinary Competition as well as the website have to include "WACS endorsed Culinary Competition".
All certificates have to bear name and signature of the WACS President and the WACS logo.

Fees to WACS 300 Euro in advanced

Organized by WACS, or a national association, or a regional association

Free WACS Info counter, shared with the organiser.

All brochures of the Culinary Competition as well as the website have to show the WACS logo. Both Web sites are to be linked.

All brochures of the Culinary Competition as well as the website have to include "WACS endorsed Culinary Competition".

All certificates have to bear name and signature of the WACS President and the WACS logo.

WACS publishes this Culinary Competition on their own website.

WACS intensively conducts promotion for this Culinary Competition.

Show for regional teams, company teams, single exhibitors. See current list on the updated website.

Furnished modern in accordance with kitchen standards and the WACS checklist

The jury and the observer will be invited at the expense of the organiser (travel expenses, accommodation, board or daily allowance).

Individual exhibitor: 3 jurors for each category, All WACS approved judges
(Category Continental & National)
