WACS Continental Director Europe Middle Region

1. Work out of a structure for the European Country Members in very close cooperation and last also an agreement with Fausto Arioldi Europe Southern Region and Gissur Gudmundsson Europe Northern Region.

9. In March I visited the Culinary School ALMA close to Parma, Italy. At this school the Students are looking to become Masterchef of Italian Cuisine.
10. At least I was in contact some people to find a way how we could establish an **International Masterchef of WACS**. I will give a result of my talks at the meeting and bring a proposal on the meeting table.
