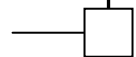

## Singapore

### Singapore Hosts its first WACS Board Meeting



Dear Culinary Professionals,

The island nation of Singapore played host to a meeting of World Association of Cooks Societies (or WACS) leaders last week in conjunction with the ongoing World Gourmet Summit 2005. Eleven executive board members and guests of the board came from countries such as South Africa, America, Portugal, Sri Lanka, Australia, New Zealand, Germany, Brazil and even as far away as Iceland to spend a few days submerged in balmy tropical weather and renowned Asian hospitality. They were hosted by WACS continental director for Asia, Frank Naesheim, of the Singapore-based Norwegian seafood supply company, Snorre Food. The meeting was held over two days, 19 and 20 April 2005 at the Orchard Hotel Singapore.

The WACS board meets about twice to three times each year and spends long hours discussing a wide variety of issues that range from membership and finances to developments and trends in the culinary profession, regional communication between chefs, charitable undertakings, or recent efforts in culinary education and certification. This last subject in particular was given much weight at the recent meeting because chef certification on a global scale, to meet a uniform global standard, is a momentous task that requires careful planning and committed execution. "Global certification makes a statement regarding the importance of career development and provides motivation for our members to unite," explained Edward Leonard, vice president of WACS, at the meeting. Based on the model adopted by the American Culinary Federation, which has proved extremely successful over the past decade, a new programme will be specially developed to offer interested individuals in all WACS member countries the opportunity to become certified as chefs, executive chefs or masterchefs. More detailed information will be communicated about this initiative when available..

Among the guests who were invited to present brief reports to the board was Murray Dick from New Zealand, the 2006 WACS Congress Director. He outlined an exciting plan for next year's congress in Auckland and was happy to report that much effort has gone into making sure this event is intensely educational, mind-challenging, and technologically advanced, but also fun, young in spirit and as affordable as it can get! "We're aiming to have about eight of the world's best ice carvers put on a little competition-show outside the congress venue, to attract public as well as media attention," he enthused.
